Submissions must be received no later than March 26, 2021. The art will be juried and you will be notified by email no later than April 6, 2021 as to whether or not your work has been accepted for the exhibit.

If your work has been accepted, it needs to be delivered to Theater for the New City on <u>April 10 between 11am-1pm</u> and will be hung that afternoon. We will live stream the exhibit over the Art Loisiada Face-Book page that evening. The exhibit will be mounted both on the TNC and ALF websites. It will also participate in FAB's LES History Month and Earth Celebration's Ecological City Events on May 8 with a Zoom opening at 6:30-8;30pm where contributing artists will speak about their work with Q&A from the audience. Cards for the exhibit will be provided and posters will be in all of TNC's spaces.

## ARTIST AGREEMENT "SURVIVING COVID" AT THEATER FOR THE NEW Сіту

You agree, if you are accepted into the exhibit:

1. Hold The Theater for the New City and any of the organizers for the exhibit blameless in the unlikely event of theft, damage or other loss of your work;

2. Theater for the New City will take a 20% commission of the purchase price if a work is sold while exhibited at the TNC Gallery);

3.(a) Deliver and pick up of your work to/from the gallery at the prescribed times; the show is up;

4. Curator will make all final decisions with regard to the placement and hanging of your work.

5. All of your work must be delivered to the gallery (Paintings (edges can be taped or stripped), mixed media, prints, collage & photographs must be framed and ready to hang (including hooks and back wire); all sculptures must be free standing and stable or you provide your own plinth /stand); and picked up on the prescribed day as there will be another exhibit moving after this one.

6. Your work will not be accepted for the exhibit without receipt of the digital ipegs at 2000 pixels(72 DPI)-color images of work, and a signed / completed contract including list of title of works, medium, & price and an artist statement that states how one's work was created in response the COVID restrictions. and

7. Theater for the New City and Art Loisaida Foundation may retain, reproduce or otherwise use the color images of your work that you submitted in connection with its promotional, educational, historical record keeping or any other activities in furtherance of its missions.
